WHAT IS APTS?

An opportunity to set aside a year to get to know God and discover your destiny.

PHILOSOPHY

Training schools were launched within our movement of churches inspired by the belief that local churches should not only win and disciple people, but also train and send laborers into harvest fields of the US and the nations of the world.

HISTORY

The first training school in our movement of churches was launched in 1987 at Highland Baptist Church in Waco, TX. The two pastors who founded the school were noticing that many college-age people were having their lives transformed through the local church but were then having to leave the church and move to other cities to attend other institutions if they wanted further training in ministry or missions. Therefore a school was birthed within the local church to give strong Biblical training and ministry skills equipping but coupled with a focus on discipleship, worship, practical service, and heart-stirring teaching.

Actually, this was no new idea, but clearly the New Testament model as seen in the Book of Acts. Thus, a school was created in which people wanting "more" were able to receive Biblical teaching and practical training while remaining in vital relationship with their local church. Since then over 800 graduates have completed these training schools located in nine churches in the US.

1/3 – CHARACTER & SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES

1/3 BIBLE KNOWLEDGE & TEACHING

To encourage you to develop a Biblical worldview, an understanding of fundamental doctrines, and to deepen your relationship with God.

1/3 MINISTRY & CHURCH PLANTING

As the book of James says, "be doers of the word and not hearers only." Our goal is not just to fill students with head knowledge, but also to empower and equip them to "do the work of the ministry" (Ephesians 4) in church settings and the marketplace.

Students will learn from experienced ministers from around the body of Christ both nationally and internationally as well as receive hands on training in San Diego, Tijuana, and on a short-term overseas mission trip.
